It starts with a promise – to give five hours of your time for your child and their school this year. Once you have decided to make the promise, please complete and return your *Give Me Five* Volunteer Sign-Up Form so you can tell us how you would like to be involved. We understand that your time is valuable, and we want to make sure that the hours that you give are rewarding, both for you and for the school. When you keep the promise to 'GIVE ME FIVE', you give your child and the whole school community your most precious gift – your time.
